

COVID-19 IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT: EXTENSION OF CONDITIONAL MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER (CMCO)

12th May 2020

Dear Students,

We hope that you are all keeping well and staying safe.

We would like to provide you with important update in relation to the Conditional Movement Control Order. As you are aware, the Prime Minister of Malaysia had announced that the **Conditional Movement Control Order will continue until 9th June 2020**. There are also very clear indications that even after the CMCO is eventually lifted, social distancing rules and bans on large gatherings are likely to continue for few weeks, or months and will be released in stages.

It appears to be increasingly inevitable that all Malaysian Universities would most likely not to be allowed to resume face-to-face classes on campus in the foreseeable future. The Ministry has also sent out a directive to all Universities prohibiting the resumption of face to face learning on campuses until it is allowed. Malaysian Universities are not alone in this; similar approaches have also been observed in many other countries around the world. We are eager to bring back all our students on campus as soon as possible.

We will continue with e-Learning, so as not to delay your course. The new intakes and semesters that will begin in June 2020 will also be on e-Learning initially, until we revert back to normal face-to-face mode after we are allowed to operate normally. For your information, more than 7,800 current APU students have successfully been on an online mode since 23rd March 2020, and even more students will be joining Online Learning classes in May.
