

# IMPORTANT ANNOUNCEMENT: COMMENCEMENT OF NEXT IEP INTAKE – 5TH MAY 2020

30th April 2020

Dear Students,

As you are aware, the Malaysian Government has declared the extension of the Movement Control Order (MCO) until 12th May 2020, to deal with the COVID-19 situation. It is however highly likely that it would take some time for conditions to normalise even after the lifting of the MCO, which has every possibility of being further extended.

More than 7,800 APU students have already been successfully attending their classes through Online Learning for the past 6 weeks, and this is expected to continue in the foreseeable future.

Taking this into consideration, to ensure that your studies are not further disrupted, we have decided to begin the next intake (F2005) through e-Learning - Online Classes starting on 5th May 2020 for all APLC students.

The classes will be delivered via remote online learning method - specifically using Microsoft Teams platform. In addition to this, Online English Learning (OEL) will continue as normal and will be guided by your respective teachers in the second week of the intake. It will follow the predefined deadline as conducted previously.

# QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE FOR STUDENTS USING APLC'S DIGITAL LEARNING PLATFORM FOR ONLINE LEARNING

Please look at the steps below:

#### A. PRE-CLASS PREPARATION:

- 1. Check your class timetable attached in this email.
- 2. Ensure you have a stable internet connection.
- 3. Ensure you have downloaded Microsoft Teams application (on phone or laptop) or you may go to the website directly at https://teams.microsoft.com/.

- 4. You DO NOT have to create a new account. You may log in to Microsoft Teams account using the same username and password for APSpace or Student Email (Eg: TP123456@mail.apu.edu.my).
- 5. After you log in, you will receive an invitation link from your teacher. Ensure you are in the appropriate Microsoft Teams Group for your corresponding classes.
- 6. Classes will be shown as an Event in Microsoft Teams. Please ensure you are aware of the timings and the updates by your teacher. All classes will be following your timetable as scheduled.

## B. JOINING THE LIVESTREAM (ONLINE CLASS) IN MICROSOFT TEAMS

- 1. Dress Code while being online do be in decent casual attire.
- 2. Ensure you are logged in at least 15 minutes before the class starts.
- 3. At the scheduled time, go to the Microsoft Teams Group for your class, and be attentive to any new posts by your teacher.
- 4. Join the Live session when it has started and follow along with your teacher.
- 5. Your attendance will be taken "live" during the online class.
