* The SOPs stated are in accordance with guidelines of MOHE, MOH, NADMA, EMGS and can be revised at anytime.



Before you make a decision to travel, please ensure that:



- 1. You are fully vaccinated against Covid-19 (see details on page 5 & 6)
- 2. The Malaysian Mission (High Commission, Embassy or Consulate) in your country is open for you to **Single Entry Visa (SEV)** if your visa has expired where applicable.
- 5. You are healthy and eligible to travel to Malaysia.

Category 1

Existing Student with Valid Student Pass

International students with the valid Student Pass are allowed to enter Malaysia without applying for the Travel Authorisation via EMGS.

Kindly note that the Student Pass must be valid in your passport at the point of entry into Malaysia.

Category 2

Existing Student with Expired Student Pass (after 1st Feb 2020)

You must apply for Travel Authorisation with EMGS if your Student Pass has expired.

Please ensure your Travel Authorisation is valid, the validity of Travel Authorization is 3 months from the date of issuance. If your Travel Authorization has expired, please follow the steps below:

Definition of "Fully Vaccinated" in Malaysia

As of 1 April 2022

18 years old and above who are fully vaccinated with two doses of the Sinovac/Sinopharm vaccine and 60 years old and above who are fully vaccinated with any type of COVID-19 vaccines are required to get a third dose of vaccine (booster) to keep their fully vaccinated status. This applies to all citizens and non-citizens.

Partially Vaccinated or Not Vaccinated Students

Existing students with Valid Student Pass

- You are required to have the following documents before the date of departure:
 - Ensure your Student Pass is valid at the point of entry into Malaysia

- All arriving students are required to download, register and activate the MySejahtera application.

- If you are **Partially Vaccinated or NOT Vaccinated** You are required to upload the results of your RT-PCR test done within **TWO (2)** days before your departure **via MySejahtera** application.



Partially Vaccinated or Not Vaccinated Students

Upon-Arrival Procedures:

- If you are Partially Vaccinated or NOT Vaccinated You are required to do a 5 days Quarantine at Quarantine Hotel.
- You will need to arrange your own transport to the Quarantine Hotel.
- You are required to undergo a supervised professional RTK-Ag test at a private health facility available in the international entry points or outside within 24 hours of your arrivals.
- <u>Check-in to APU accommodation is only allowed for those who are FULLY Vaccinated</u> and have completed their 5 days Quarantine and supervised professional RTK-Ag Test.






Digital Pre-Departure Form in MySejahtera

Pre-departure Procedures:

All students arriving into Malaysia are required to complete the
 Digital Pre-Departure Form (DPDF). The DPDF can be found
 under the 'Traveller' icon on the MySejahtera application. The
 DPDF requests details that are considered critical health
 information. Travellers must have the DPDF completed before
 check-in to be allowed to board their flight.







 You are required to upload the results of your RT-PCR test done within TWO (2) days before your departure if you are Partially Vaccinated or Not Vaccinated.





Updating your Vaccination Status in 'MySejahtera' Mobile App









Single Entry Visa Requirements: Existing Student with expired Student Pass

If your Student Pass has expired after 1st Feb 2020. You may also need to apply Single Entry Visa (where applicable). It may take 3-7 working days.

If your Student Pass has expired after 1st Feb 2020. You may also need to apply Single Entry Visa - For countries that require visa to enter Malaysia, you are also REQUIRED to apply for Single Entry Visa at the nearest Malaysian Embassy / High Commission / Consulate General. (Please see page no. 13 and 14 for details on which countries required SEV)

STUDENTS FROM THE FOLLOWING VISA REQUIRED NATIONAL MUST OBTAIN SINGLE ENTRY VISA (SEV) FROM MALAYSIA REPRESENTATIVE OFFICE OVERSEA BEFORE ENTERING MALAYSIA. STUDENTS MUST ALSO PROVIDE VISA APPROVAL LETTER (VAL) AT THE POINT OF ENTRY
