* The SOPs stated are in accordance with guidelines of MOHE, MOH, NADMA, EMGS and can be revised at anytime.




Before you make a decision to travel, please ensure that:



- 1. You are **fully vaccinated** against Covid-19 (see details on page 6)
- 2. You have been issued a e-VAL (Visa Approval Letter) and is Valid and not Expired. The e-VAL validity period is 6 months from the date of issuance. (We will be extending the expired VALs upon requests and subject to Immigration's approval).
- 3. Please note that your **Passport** must be **valid for at least 18 months** from the expected date of VAL Issuance. For example, 10th Feb 2022 means your passport must be valid at least until 15th Aug 2023.
- 4. The Malaysian Mission (High Commission, Embassy or Consulate) in your country is open for you to apply **Single Entry Visa (SEV)** where applicable.
- 5. You are healthy and eligible to travel to Malaysia.
- 6. You have secured Accommodation for your stay in Malaysia. Please fill the Declaration of Accommodation http://tiny.cc/AccommodationDeclaration



Important Reminder - Passport Expiry Date



- Please note that your Passport must be valid for at least 18 months from the expected date of VAL Issuance. For example, 10th March 2022 means your passport must be valid at least until 15th September 2023.
- Our Visa Processing Team will revert to you if you have to extend your passport for the issuance of eVAL (Visa Approval Letter).

Definition of "Fully Vaccinated" in Malaysia

As of 1 April 2022

18 years old and above who are fully vaccinated with two doses of the Sinovac/Sinopharm vaccine and 60 years old and above who are fully vaccinated with any type of COVID-19 vaccines are required to get a third dose of vaccine (booster) to keep their fully vaccinated status. This applies to all citizens and non-citizens.

Pre-departure Procedures:

- You are required to have the following documents before the date of departure:
 - Visa Approval Letter (eVAL) Validity period of 6 months from the date of issuance
 - Flight tickets and copy of Passport
 - Single Entry Visa For countries that require visa to enter Malaysia, you are also REQUIRED to apply for a Visa with Reference (VDR) at the nearest Malaysian Embassy / High Commission / Consulate General together with Travel Authorisation (Please see page no. 13 and 14 for details).
- All arriving students are required to download, register and activate the MySejahtera application.
- Fill up the **Digital Pre-Depature form** that can be accessed via the **'Traveller'** icon in the **MySejahtera** application (see guideline on page 11)
- Update their vaccination details on the MySejahtera app (see guideline on page 12).
- Fill up the **EMGS Pre-Entry Checklist** at least 3 days prior to their departure through **EMGS Connect** Mobile App. Please see guidelines here https://educationmalaysia.gov.my/news_update/introduction-of-the-pre-entry-checklist-emgs-connect-mobile-application/
- Pre-arrival Covid-19 tests and on-arrival tests are not required
- Email your arrival details & flight ticket to arrivals@apu.edu.my





Upon-Arrival Procedures:

• Please do connect to Airport WIFI to be able to communicate by Whatsapp with APU Arrival Team. Our APU staff member will meet you at the Arrival Hall after immigration clearance and after you have collected your luggage





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- If you are **Partially Vaccinated or NOT Vaccinated** You are required to upload the results of your RT-PCR test done within **TWO** (2) days before your departure **via MySejahtera** application.



Partial Vaccinated or Not Vaccinated Students

Upon-Arrival Procedures:

- If you are Partially Vaccinated or NOT Vaccinated You are required to do a 5 days Quarantine at Quarantine Hotel.
- You will need to arrange your own transport to the Quarantine Hotel.
- You are required to undergo a supervised professional RTK-Ag test at a private health facility available in the international entry points or outside within 24 hours of your arrivals.
- <u>Check-in to APU accommodation is only allowed for those who are FULLY Vaccinated</u> and have completed their 5 days Quarantine and supervised professional RTK-Ag Test.

Note:

APU will only arrange Airport Pickup for those who are Fully Vaccinated. If you are partially vaccinated or Not Vaccinated, you will need to Quarantine at Hotel for 5 days and arrange own transportation.






Digital Pre-Departure Form in MySejahtera

Pre-departure Procedures:

All students arriving into Malaysia are required to complete the
 Digital Pre-Departure Form (DPDF). The DPDF can be found
 under the 'Traveller' icon on the MySejahtera application. The
 DPDF requests details that are considered critical health
 information. Travellers must have the DPDF completed before
 check-in to be allowed to board their flight.







 You are required to upload the results of your RT-PCR test done within TWO (2) days before your departure if you are Partially Vaccinated or Not Vaccinated.

Single Entry Visa (SEV) - Required

STUDENTS FROM THE FOLLOWING VISA REQUIRED NATIONAL MUST OBTAIN SINGLE ENTRY VISA (SEV) FROM MALAYSIA REPRESENTATIVE OFFICE OVERSEA BEFORE ENTERING MALAYSIA. STUDENTS MUST ALSO PROVIDE VISA APPROVAL LETTER (VAL) AT THE POINT OF ENTRY




Campus Arrival





- 1. Registration & Student Welcome.
- 2. APU Accommodation Check-in (where applicable).
- 3. Medical Screening (within 7 days of your arrival in Malaysia).
- 4. Submit Passport for Student Pass Endorsement (3 to 4 days after Medical Screening).
- 5. Passport Collection after 1-2 weeks for processing.
- 6. Bank Account Opening (after your Student Pass is endorsed).
- 7. Health Insurance Card Collection & i-Kad (normally 2-3 weeks after Passport Endorsement).

1. Do I need to bring cash with me?
