

IMPORTANT UPDATE: COMMENCEMENT OF ONLINE DIGITAL LEARNING

21st March 2020



Further to our notification to you at 11:13pm on 17th March regarding the suspension of Digital Online Learning following the circular issued by the Ministry of Higher Education, we would like to inform you that the Ministry has issued a statement indicating conditional approval for online learning to go ahead.

Therefore, Online Learning will now proceed from Monday, 23rd March 2020 in phases. This later commencement date is planned to accommodate a significant number of our international students who are flying back to their home countries during this period.

As it has been previously stated, there may be teething issues as this is rolled out. However, APU /APIIT will endeavour to ensure to ensure stability.

There will be no face-to-face physical classes on campus and all teaching learning support activities, resources and administrative services on campus remain closed in full compliance of the Restricted Movement Order until 31st March 2020.

All other aspects related to the delivery of online learning remain the same as announced in our earlier communications to you on Tuesday, 17th March 2020.

It is extremely important that you check your APSpace and e-mail frequently for any updates.
