

EXTENSION OF CONDITIONAL MOVEMENT CONTROL ORDER (CMCO)

Thursday, 28th December 2020

Following the recent announcement by the Senior Minister for Security, the Conditional Movement Control Order (CMCO) in Kuala Lumpur & Selangor has been extended to Thursday, 14 January 2021.

All university campuses will continue to be closed for physical teaching & learning activities, and a majority of our staff members & lecturers will continue to perform their lectures & duties from home as per the CMCO SOPs. Essential services such as visa services, administrative services, accommodation services and bursary services will continue to operate. However, entry to the campus will continue to be restricted and students are required to make an appointment here 24 hours prior to their visit: http://www.apu.edu.my/explore-apu/contact-us.
